

Dear Chaffey Community –

On January 5, 2022, California Department of Public Health (CDPH) provided updated guidance to all Californian’s regarding the use of face masks. The updated guidance extends the requirement for universal masking indoors statewide from December 15, 2021, through February 15, 2022.

To ensure that we collectively protect the health and well-being of all Californians; keep schools open for in-person instruction; and allow California’s economy to remain open and thrive, the CPDH is requiring masks to be worn in all indoor public settings, irrespective of vaccine status, until February 15, 2022. This requirement will be updated as CDPH continues to assess conditions on an ongoing basis.

This measure brings an added layer of mitigation as the Omicron variant, a Variant of Concern, as labeled by the World Health Organization, continues to increase in prevalence across California, the United States, and the world and spreads much more easily than the original SAR-CoV-2 virus and Delta variant.

Cloth face coverings are no longer recommended as a layer of protection from the virus, and masks with a good fit must be worn to comply with CDPH guidance. Surgical (3-ply) masks, or higher-level respirators (e.g., N95s, KN95s, and KF94’s) are the only listed options outlined in current CDPH guidance.

The District has ample inventory of surgical (3-ply) and N95 masks. Surgical (3-ply) masks have been placed in classroom and lab environments for many months, and additional inventory can be requested via the SchoolDude work order system, or by calling the maintenance office @ 909-652-6716.

Anyone wanting to voluntarily wear an N95 mask must complete required Cal/OSHA documentation (**29 CFR 1910.134, Appendix D – (Mandatory) Information for Employees Using respirators When Not required Under the Standard**) prior to the issuance of an N95 mask. N95 masks and required Cal/OSHA forms will be available at the campus locations listed below.
